Upon completion of the program of study in William Carey University School of Allied Health Professions, the health information management graduate is expected to be able to perform the following competencies:

- Synthesize knowledge from a liberal arts education, the Christian domain, and Health Information Management to manage healthcare data in a variety settings.
- Manage health data records and ensure that documentation in the health record supports the client's diagnosis and reflects the client's progress, clinical findings and discharge status.
- Develop, implement and maintain organization-wide health record documentation guidelines that are consistent with organization and industry regulations and standards and will prepare the institution for the accreditation process.
- Apply concepts of health information management to the implementation and management of processes needed for accurate clinical classification and coding.
- Implement various reimbursement methodologies necessary to manage the use of clinical data and to participate in revenue cycle management.
- Analyze clinical data utilizing quality management tools necessary for performance improvement programs to ensure quality, safety, and effectiveness of healthcare.
- Apply concepts of confidentiality in the management of healthcare data and in the development of privacy training programs to be utilized in the health information infrastructure.
